The topics covered in AOK's Business Series (available in English, Spanish, & Chinese) are listed here and equate 34 hours of professional development for FCC educators.

AOK will provide detailed training guides and implementation support as trainers implement this Series in their communities.

BUSINESS TRAIN-THE-TRAINER STRUCTURE

- **FREQUENCY:** Check the schedule on our training website
- **TIME:** Five and a half hours daily with breaks
- **LOCATION:** Virtual on Zoom (Computer required)
- **COST:** Check the cost on our training website

Cost covers the week-long training and box of materials, access to the curriculum in multiple languages, a quarterly community of learning for trained trainers, and a bi-annual newsletter.
